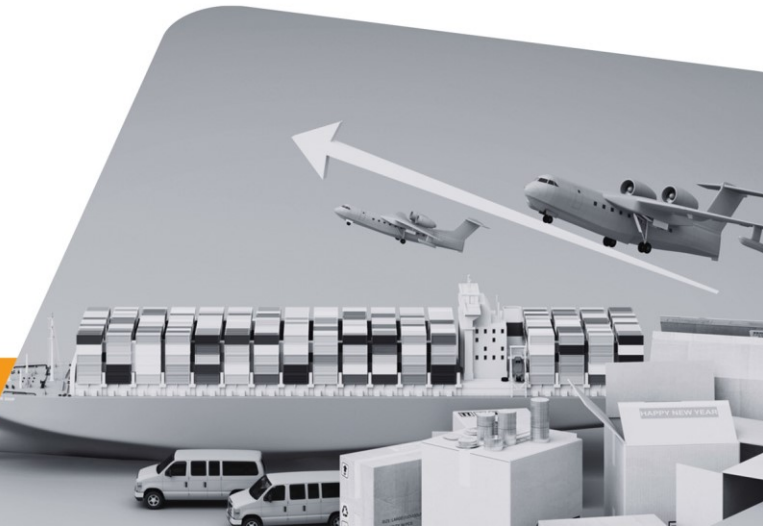

PAKISTAN ECONOMY UPDATES

CRISIS IN THE GULF: PAKISTAN PORTS SEIZE THE MOMENT



Between March and June 2026, Pakistani ports saw a sharp rise in cargo handling compared to the same period in 2025. Disruptions in Gulf shipping routes diverted vessels toward Karachi Port Trust and Port Qasim, boosting throughput across petroleum, LPG, containers, and bulk commodities.

At Port Qasim, petroleum volumes in March alone reached about 417,000 metric tons against an average of 250,000 metric tons the year before, while LPG handling more than doubled. Karachi Port also recorded daily cargo throughput of over 165,000 tons, far higher than its usual 95,000 to 100,000 tons in 2025, with container transshipment and exports of cement and clinker rising by more than half.

These gains were supported by operational upgrades and government policies including up to 60 % concessions in port charges to attract foreign flagged transshipment vessels. The surge strengthened Pakistan's role as a regional hub, though analysts note that the growth is closely tied to temporary instability in Gulf shipping lanes and may ease once conditions normalize.

PAKISTAN WITH SAUDI PARTNERS TO DEVELOP MARITIME DISTRICT AT KARACHI PORT



Pakistan has signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with Saudi and local firms to explore the development of a maritime business district on the Karachi Port Trust's (KPT) waterfront land, the maritime ministry said on Saturday.

The 140-acre maritime business district project, featuring modern commercial infrastructure, will be developed at the KPT to transform the area into a major commercial and maritime hub, the maritime affairs ministry said. It would aim to attract investment, create jobs and support urban development.

The MoU was signed between the KPT, the Saudi Business Council-NAJD Gateway Holding Company, Arif Habib Dolmen REIT Management Limited, and the Pakistan Corporate Consortium, the maritime affairs ministry said. "This strategic collaboration is a transformative opportunity to unlock the full potential of Karachi Port Trust's waterfront assets and position Pakistan as a regional hub for maritime commerce and investment," Pakistan Maritime Affairs Minister Junaid Anwar Chaudhry said.

The agreement is in line with Pakistan's efforts to promote its ports as gateways for trade with landlocked Central Asian states. Islamabad has pursued partnerships with foreign investors to expand port capacity, logistics networks and related infrastructure in recent months.

KGTL DREDGING COMPLETION MARKS A NEW CHAPTER FOR PAKISTAN'S TRADE



The dredging completion at Karachi Gateway Terminal Limited marks a major boost for Pakistan's maritime trade. By deepening channels and berths to 14–15.5 meters, Karachi Port can now host vessels up to 350 meters long and bulk carriers of 120,000 metric tons—doubling past capacity. This upgrade, part of AD Ports Group's USD 200 million investment, lowers freight costs, improves cargo flow, and strengthens competitiveness.

Beyond dredging, modernization includes expanding container capacity to 1 million TEUs annually, installing new cranes, and building Pakistan's first bulk export facility with warehouses and silos to support agriculture and commodities. Exporters gain efficiency, importers benefit from reduced costs, and shipping lines enjoy reliability. Overall, the project transforms Karachi Port into a modern regional hub, securing long-term economic growth.

PAKISTAN CURRENT ACCOUNT POSTS SURPLUS OF \$459 MN IN MAY '26:



In May 2026, Pakistan's current account showed a surplus of \$459 million, reversing April's deficit and raising hopes of ending the fiscal year with a surplus or only a small deficit. For July–May FY26, the cumulative surplus was \$255 million, lower than the \$1.6 billion recorded in the same period of FY25. Analysts attributed the May surplus mainly to strong remittance inflows, which reached \$4.2 billion in that month. The government has now set a higher remittance target of \$42.4 billion for FY27, as remittances remain vital for foreign exchange and exceed export earnings by more than 25 percent.

Despite this cushion, the trade deficit widened to \$35 billion during July–May FY26, absorbing much of the remittance inflows. On the investment side, foreign direct investment fell sharply, declining by 28 percent compared to last year.

Sector-wise, electricity and gas supply attracted the highest inflows at \$1.08 billion, while financial and insurance activities received \$808 million. Overall, while remittances have supported the current account and provided stability.
