PAKISTAN ECONOMY UPDATES

PAKISTAN

ABOLISHES EXPORT DEVELOPMENT SURCHARGE



Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif has abolished the 0.25% Export Development Surcharge (EDS) in order to provide relief to exporters and enhance Pakistan's competitiveness in international markets. The decision was taken after reviewing recommendations from a dedicated working group comprising public and private sector representatives. The prime minister also directed an immediate review and revamp of the Trade Development Authority of Pakistan to make it more effective in supporting exports.

The abolition of the Export Development Surcharge will directly reduce the cost burden on exporters, making Pakistani products more price-competitive in international markets. It is expected to encourage higher export volumes, improve foreign exchange earnings, and enhance investor confidence in the export sector. Moreover, better utilisation of the Export Development Fund for research, innovation, and skill development will strengthen productivity and long-term growth of Pakistan's export-oriented industries.



PAKISTAN BEGINS CONSTRUCTION OF PNSC CONTAINER SHIP AT KARACHI SHIPYARD



Pakistan has launched the construction of a 1,100 TEU container ship for the Pakistan National Shipping Corporation (PNSC) at Karachi Shipyard, marking a significant step toward strengthening the country's maritime capacity.

The project was formally inaugurated by Federal Minister for Maritime Affairs Junaid Anwar Chaudhry during a steel-cutting ceremony. The vessel will be built entirely with domestic resources, showcasing growing confidence in Pakistan's shipbuilding industry. This initiative is expected to reduce reliance on foreign shipping lines and save valuable foreign exchange while expanding the operational capacity of the PNSC fleet.

The minister emphasized that expanding the national maritime fleet is crucial for reinforcing the supply chain and supporting trade activity across the country. He also highlighted that the project will generate employment opportunities for skilled workers and contribute to the development of Pakistan's maritime workforce. Karachi Shipyard is emerging as a central hub for national maritime development, with shipbuilding and repair identified as key pillars of Pakistan's maritime policy. Stressing the importance of the sector, Chaudhry noted that around 95% of Pakistan's trade is conducted via sea routes, underscoring the need for a strong, self-reliant maritime industry to support sustainable economic growth.

2ND PAKISTAN INTERNATIONAL MARITIME EXPO & CONFERENCE



The four-day Pakistan International Maritime Expo and Conference 2025 (PIMEC-25) was held in Karachi early November 2025. The event received an overwhelming international response, featuring participation from 178 exhibitors, including 28 international firms and 150 local organisations showcasing a wide range of maritime innovations, technologies and services.

The main attractions at the Expo had been the Juggernaut multi-rotor munition drone and the long-range kamikaze (loitering munition) drone Sarfarosh, two big heroes of the recent Pakistan-India conflict.

The chief guest, announced the establishment of Pakistan's first Green Ship Repair and Recycling Yard at Port Qasim.

PIMEC-25 marked a major milestone in advancing Pakistan's maritime and blue economy agenda, with the signing of 83 Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) worth

Rs 76 billion between national and international exhibitors across multiple maritime sectors.

The MoU signings at PIMEC-25 serve as a concrete signal from Pakistan to international investors, emphasising its commitment to fostering strategic partnerships, promoting technology transfer, enhancing capacity building, and unlocking large-scale opportunities in the maritime sector.

The successful conclusion of PIMEC-25 not only highlights Pakistan's potential as a maritime hub but also reflects the nation's growing role in shaping the regional blue economy landscape.

FOREIGN EXCHANGE RESERVES HIT RECORD HIGH SINCE MARCH 2022



Pakistan's foreign exchange reserves have surged to \$21.1B, the highest since March 2022, reflecting sustainable growth, strong investor confidence, and improved fiscal discipline. This achievement reflects sustainable economic growth and strong investor confidence in the country's leadership.

The State Bank of Pakistan's (SBP) reserves are recorded at \$15.9 billion, while the country's import cover has now surpassed 2.6 months.

Economic experts stated that the recent increase in reserves is not driven by loans, but rather by local economic growth, reforms, and the restoration of confidence.

Experts further emphasized that the increase in reserves is not a temporary adjustment, but a result of a clear and sustainable economic recovery.

In 2023, the central bank's reserves had plunged to just \$2.9 billion, but they have now increased by nearly five and a half times, reaching approximately \$15.9 billion.

Economic experts believed that the reduction in the debt-to-GDP ratio, stronger foreign exchange reserves, increased business confidence, and overall economic stability are key indicators of this progress.

LARGEST-EVER CONTAINER SHIP BERTHED AT KARACHI

KARACHI: Hutchison Ports Pakistan, the country's only deep-water container terminal, has berthed MSC MICOL, the largest vessel in the country's history.



The 400-metre-long container ship has a capacity of 24,070 TEUs, making it one of the most advanced vessels globally and the largest to call at a Pakistani port.

The berthing of MSC MICOL marks a significant milestone, highlighting the terminal's capacity to handle ultra-large vessels, said a press release.

Handling larger vessels enhances trade efficiency and helps reduce freight costs, supporting the country's export competitiveness and lowering import expenses.

Maritime Minister Muhammad Junaid Anwar Chaudhry termed the berthing a historic event that strengthens Pakistan's position as a regional shipping hub.

Separately, two subsidiaries of Pakistan National Shipping Corporation — Karachi Shipping and Lahore Shipping — signed agreements to acquire two Aframax tankers, LORAX and NAFSIKA, with deadweight tonnage of 109,990 and 112,051 tonnes, respectively.

PNSC earlier approved a \$193.1 million plan to expand its fleet to 30 vessels by 2026.

PRIVATIZATION OF PAKISTAN INTERNATIONAL AIRLINES



Pakistan International Airlines (PIA) once enjoyed a glorious past and was regarded as one of the leading airlines in Asia. It set high standards of service, punctuality, and professionalism, and even helped other international airlines like Emirates Airline in their early stages. PIA was a symbol of national pride and excellence in aviation.

However, over the years the airline faced a steady downfall due to mismanagement, political interference, overstaffing, and financial losses. Poor decision-making and outdated practices further weakened its performance and reputation.

To address these challenges, the government initiated the process of privatization through transparent bidding. PIA has been acquired by a consortium led by Arif Habib Corporation, which purchased a 75% majority stake in January 2026.

The investor has assured improvement in governance, customer service, and route profitability. This move aimed to reduce the burden on the national exchequer and restore PIA's competitiveness.

With professional management and fresh investment, there are strong hopes for PIA's future performance. The privatization is expected to revive the airline and once again make it a proud representative of Pakistan in the global aviation industry.

BREAKFAST WITH MANAGING DIRECTOR MR. DANISH A. SIDDIQUI

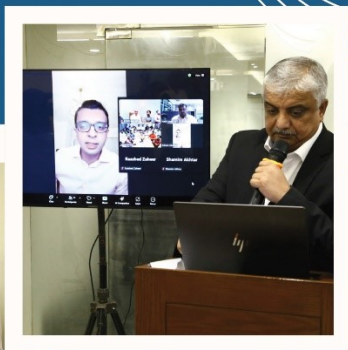

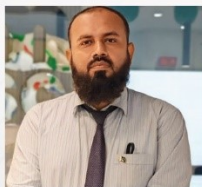

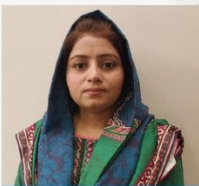
